As part of our History learning into the Vikings, we are extremely excited to have have booked a one-day Viking workshop with *Portals to the Past* on Thursday 30th January.

We are very fortunate to be welcoming Ian, the workshop leader to our school, who has delivered both Anglo-Saxon and Viking workshops to our Year 4 children for many years. The children will travel back in time to the age of the Vikings, taking part in several activities across the day, to learn about many aspects of Viking life from Ian- who delivers a sterling performance as a Viking! So much so, even Mr Garwood is convinced that he may really be the last-surviving Viking in this country!

To make the day more authentic we are asking the children to dress up. They can dress as a Viking warrior or villager, in a simple knee length tunic, a belt and trousers.
