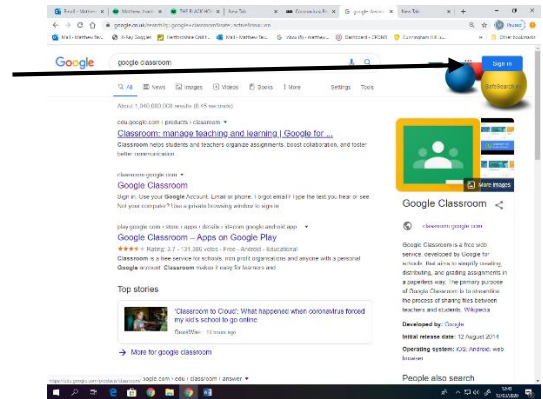


Accessing Google Classroom at Home:

The children should log into Google classroom everyday where they will find work. This may be a document within google classroom or links to a variety of online sources.

Step 1: Search for: Google Classroom and follow the link to the page. Click on the link and sign in at the top. Google Classroom works best from an internet browser. If using an android device or newer Ipad this will run through your normal internet.

If using an older Ipad, you may need to also add the following Google Apps:
Google Classroom, Docs, Slides and Drive.



Step 2: Sign in using the following format:

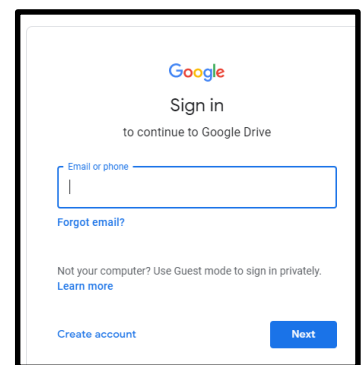

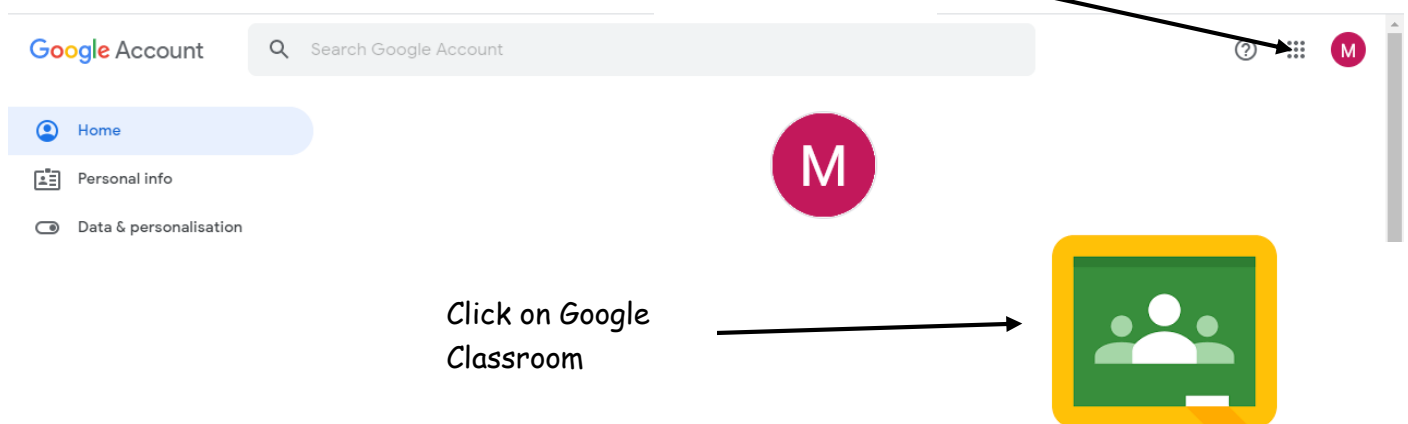

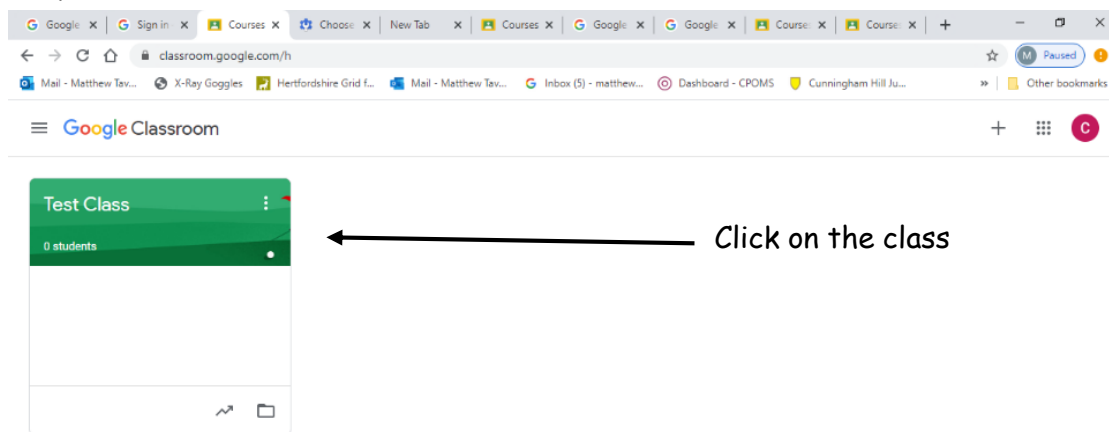
Step 3: Open Google Classroom

(If at first it does not appear, click 'account').

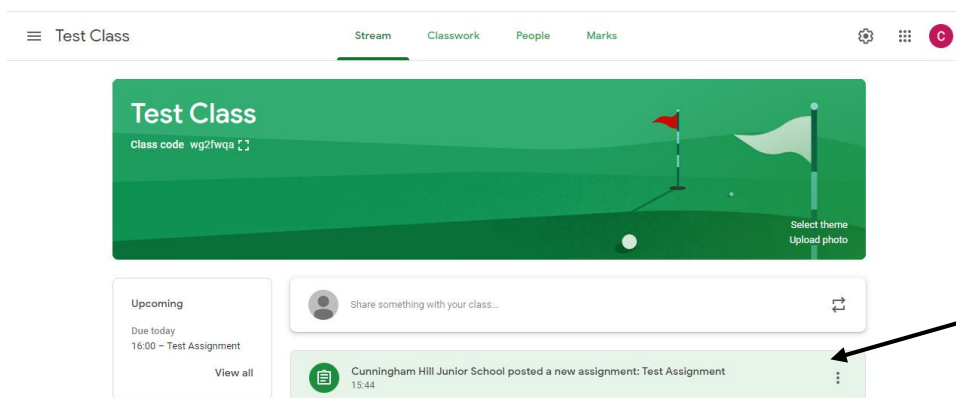
Tick on the dots



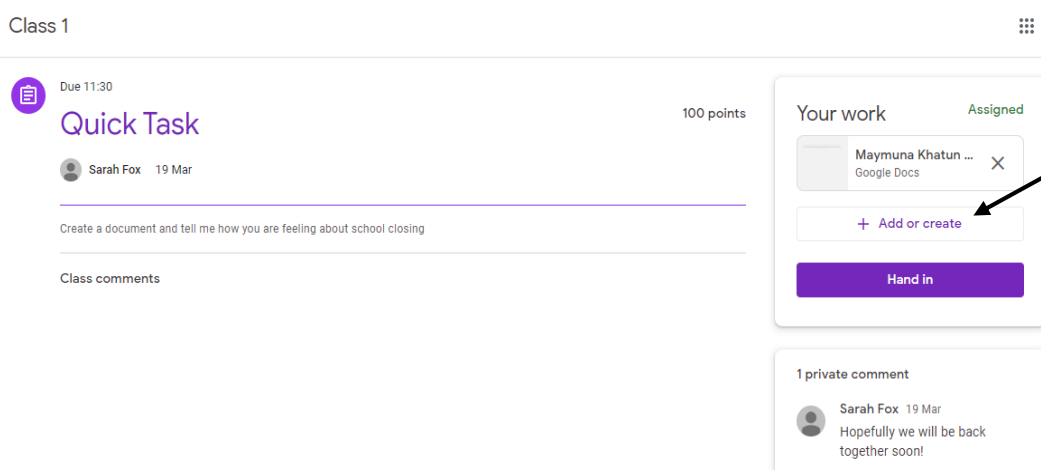
Step 4: Click on the class.



Step 5: New work will be posted each day and the children will need to click on the assignment.



Step 6: Instructions will be given as to what it is that needs to be done.



Step 7: When the children have finished their work they must press 'Turn In' at the top of the page and then it will return to the page above where it will say 'Hand In'

If the work is not being completed within Google, they should still press 'Hand In' so their teacher knows that they have completed the task.
